Petit Jean November Dance Weekend

November 7th – 9th, 2008



Petit Jean State Park

Join us at Petit Jean State Park for great dancing, music, fellowship, hiking, and plenty of fresh mountain air. We will have Contras, Squares, English Country Dance, Waltzes, Style sessions, and much more.

Friday, November 7th there will be a social dance at the Petit Jean State Park Rec Hall in the evening from 8-10pm.

Saturday, November 8th there will be workshops during the day with an evening social dance from 7-10pm. There will NOT be a potluck before the dance but you may bring snack foods if you wish for munching during the dance.

Sunday, November 9th there will be a workshop in the morning and a social dance to top off the weekend.

Accommodations:

Fran LaFace has booked blocks of rooms at Mather Lodge and Winthrop Rockefeller Conference Center. Plus, camping is available in Petit Jean State Park. Please contact Fran at 501-327-5739 or fclaface@swbell.net if you wish to stay at either the Lodge or "WinRock." Mather Lodge rooms run about \$70 per night and require a two night stay. Winrock rooms run about \$75 per night and only require a one night stay. For camping, contact PJSP at 501-727-5441.

Food:

There are restaurants on Petit Jean Mountain at both the Mather Lodge and Winrock. Mather Lodge serves breakfast, lunch and dinner from 7am to 8pm. Winrock has a nice restaurant with a well-known chef and fine cuisine and it also serves breakfast, lunch, and dinners. For Saturday night, there will NOT be a potluck but dancers may bring a snack to share during the social dance from 7-10pm.

Weather:

The weather in November is variable so bring layers. It is typically 60's in the day time and 40's at night.

Hiking:

There are a number of great scenic hiking trails in Petit Jean State Park with hikes ranging from 1 ½ to 10 miles. Pick up a trail guide at the PJSP Visitor's Center and enjoy!

Registration:

Cost is \$20 per person. You don't have to pre-register but it helps us get a count of participants and pay for the Hall!

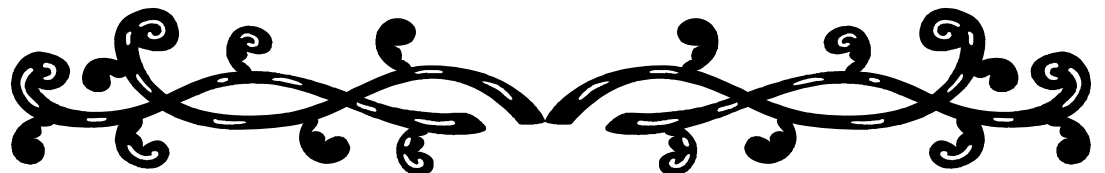
